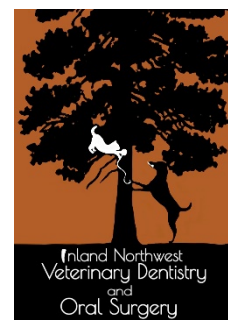
Saturday, April 29th and Sunday, April 30, 2023
